THE EXHIBITION SPACE HANGING SYSTEM

THE HANGING SYSTEM

- The Balmain Association has installed a new and easier to use hanging system. It's from *The Gallery System* and consists of stainless steel cables in 3 different lengths, based on the height of the hanging rail in each room. These are suitable for hanging up to 80 items throughout the Watch House.
- Approximate materials available are 2m cables 80, 1.5m cables 50, 1m cables 10 and hooks 170.
- Metal hooks hold the art works and they slide up and down the cables locking into position on the cables. To lower the hooks press down on the ring at the top of the hook and simply slide upwards to heighten.
- Additional cables which are located in the kitchen should more be needed in a particular location. If you use these please return these to the kitchen railing.
- More than one hook can be used on a single cable and additional hooks are in the desk drawer in the foyer. Existing cables are not to be removed from the hanging rails in each room. If cables are not needed slide to one corner of the room. If unsightly remove the hooks so the cable will not be obvious.
- Do not bend the cable in any way they kink easily. If the cables are bent or twisted they cannot be re-used and a charge will be uncured for replacement of each damaged cable. Please take care and leave the space in good order for the next exhibitor.
